## **FuelRod Mobile Charger Kiosks Arrive at McCarran International Airport Las Vegas**

*LAS travelers no longer have to roll the dice to keep their Smartphones charged*

FuelRod’s kiosks are conveniently located throughout McCarran Airport and can be found in Terminal 1 near Gate C21, Terminal 3 by Gate E10, and in all four food court areas of the D Concourse. FuelRod’s self-serve “SwapBox” provides travelers with ready-to-use, grab-and-go mobile device chargers that eliminate the need for charging at the airport’s electrical outlets. SwapBox kiosks are also available for patrons of The CLUB at LAS located in the D Concourse and in Terminal 3.

Instead of searching for an electrical outlet or stationary charging station, mobile device users can purchase a FuelRod charging kit complete with cables and adaptors at the FuelRod kiosks to fuel up their mobile device. The rechargeable FuelRods are small portable chargers that deliver up to eight hours of talk time for an Apple® or Android™ smartphone or nearly four hours of usage for a tablet. Priced at just \$20 each with free unlimited exchanges, each FuelRod kit includes connectors for both Android and Apple-based devices. Once used, the FuelRod module can be recharged using any standard USB outlet or it can be quickly exchanged at any FuelRod SwapBox kiosk for a fresh, fully fueled, ready-to-use charger.

“The traveler experience here at McCarran International Airport is like no other in the United States. There is so much to do and experience including shopping, dining and gaming while waiting for flights,” said Scott Kichline, Assistant Director of Aviation. “The portable chargers at the FuelRod kiosks are a great way to free passengers from the time and stress of recharging their smart devices.
